



Report:

The Electoral Laws (Reform) Bill 2021 which was passed in the winter session suggests the linking of Aadhaar Card with Voter ID of the voter.

The Election Commission of India has informed that the Commission will link Aadhaar number with entry in electoral roll in accordance with the extant Standard Operating Procedure prescribed by the UIDAI.

The linking of aadhar with voting id is to be done after. The procedure of linking Aadhaar card to Voter ID is very simple and can be done via any one of the multiple methods using the internet, SMS, phone call, or by visiting a booth-level officer. But what entails is a difficult set of questions that need to be evaluated carefully as the changes to the Electoral Laws are bound to have a serious impact on how the Indian Democracy functions.

Christian College of Engineering and Technology under the NSS Club have organized one day campaign for linking Aadhar with Voter ID card on **09-12-2022**. The coordinator for the program was Prashant Bawaney. There was a single day session on how to link Aadhar with voting ID. The key points of the session were: Why is it important to link Aadhar with pan card?; How is it linked?; and, Why is it important to cast vote?

More than 45 students have attended the session and all have understood the meaning and importance of voting and linking Aadhar with the voting id.

"The reasons behind linking Voter IDs with Aadhaar numbers were, streamlining of electoral rolls and the process of registration of migrated voters without duplication in electoral rolls and curbing the menace of multiple enrollment of the same persons in different places"

The linking of an Aadhaar card to Voter ID is voluntary, and as per the provisions of the bill, no one shall be restricted from entering their names in electoral rolls even if they do not have an Aadhaar card.

With an objective to create awareness about fire safety and the usage of fire extinguishing equipment, a Fire Safety Awareness Programme was conducted at CCET Bhilai June 13, 2023. The programme aimed at making the employees and students of the Institute mindful about fire hazards and the safety measures which can be taken during fire emergency. Mr Ram Kotikala was invited speaker.

He discussed about several types of materials which cause fire and how that fire can be ceased. Giving examples of fire emerged due to petrol and LPG he also discussed the scientific reasons behind why some things catch fire quickly, while some items are the last to burn, like bricks. Mr. Ram Kotikala mentioned that fire equipment is manufactured on the basis of five types of fire which are categorized as follows:

Type A- Caused due to wood, cloth, coal

Type B- Caused due to all kinds of inflammable liquids like kerosene, petrol

Type C- Caused due to all kinds of inflammable gases

Type D- Caused due to rise in temperature of various metals

Type E- Caused due to short-circuit in any electric equipment

Mr. Kotikala also discussed about the safety measures at home and public places. The talk was followed by a Q&A session.

The Fire Brigade Department also conducted a mock drill and gave a demonstration of how fire extinguishers can be used to cease a fire caused due to petrol and diesel.

The workshop was attended by the administration and security staff of CCET Bhilai.

The NSS Cell of CCET, Bhilai conducted this health awareness programme for around 150 students on health awareness covid 19 and hand hygiene.



The webinar facilitated a deeper understanding of anemia and its impact on individuals and communities.


