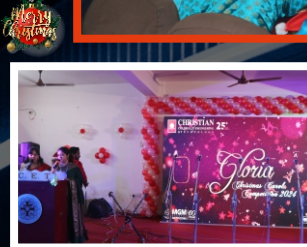
# Christmas Carol

# CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM

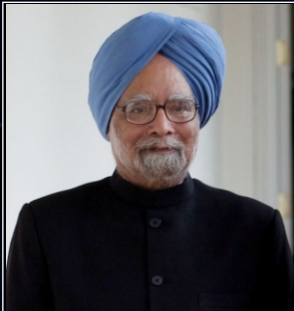
The NSS team of our college successfully organized a series of Career Guidance Programs aimed at inspiring and guiding young students toward their future career paths. The sessions were held at:

# CREATIVE Corner

## Origin of Assam

## The Arrival of सुकफ़ा
