


EXPERT TALK ON ENTREPRENEURSHIP BY MR. MAULI CHANDRA

Origin of Assam

The Brahmaputra River lay shrouded in mist as Arun, a young historian stood by its bank clutching an ancient manuscript left to him by his late grandfather, he left a Surge of curiosity. The wars ended, and under Rudra Singha's reign peace and prosperity blossomed Arun imagined Vibrant festivals and flowrishing trade, a stark contrast to the chaos of war. The Ahoms' daily life revolved around agriculture, community and tradition. They practiced ancestor warship and cele brated festival 'like Bihu, blending spirituality with nature. The "Me-Dam-Me-Phi" ceremony was a significant event where they prayed to ancestars for Prosperity and protection.

Their daily lives were centered around agriculture, with sice being their staple food. Leadership was merit-based, chosen by a council of nobles. This unique govermance, along with their hormonious way of life, defined the Ahoms' enduring. legacy.

The final Revelation

Emerging from the palace, Arun watched the dawn break over the Brahmaputra. He reflected on how the Ahoms unity and resilience had shaded shaped Assam. But the manuscripts final words revealed a tragic twist: the Mamoria Rebellion and Bwimese invasions in the 18th Century weakned the Kindom . Outnumbered and ill, Lachit inspired histroops with a flery speech; (Jf you value your honown, fight until the last breath).

Against all odds, the Ahoms triumphed, their victory a testament to resilience. But Lachits health deteriorated soonafter, underscorring the personal sacrifices behind their success.


The manuscript guided Asun to Sivasagar, the Ahom Capital , where the kaseng Ghar palace loomed. Inside, Asun found a musial depicting. Sukaphaa with a golden staff before a concealed door following. the clues, Asun discovered a hidden stairma leading to an underground chamber. There, he found an ornate box holding ancient manuscripts-the chronides of the Ahoms.

One letter stood out, written by the last Ahom King Pwandar Singha. It read: "(one time has passed, but our script endures. Assam is more than land; it is an ideq - a blend of resilience, unity, and identity. Protect it, for it carries the essence of our sacrifices.)"

Asun felt teass prick his eyes. The Ahoms' story wasn't just one of power as conquest - it was a tale of Survival, innovation, and an unbreakable spirit.

"A Kingdom may fall, but its dreams live on in the hearts of its people"

And as the siver flowed, carrying the whispers of the Ahom into the future. Asun vowed to ensure their legacy was never forgotten. And as the Brahmaput Curried the whispers of the past into the future, the essence of the Ahoms endured - a dream of resilience and harmony.
